Your Child's Report

Dear parent / carer,

I am delighted to share your child's end-of-year report with you. The report has been designed to give you the information that you really want as a parent / carer. We have also tried to make sure that the information in your child's report is clear and easy to understand.

Your child's report includes a general comment from their class teacher. This is where your child's teacher has celebrated your child's individual successes and achievements as well as identifying any areas for improvement or development next year.

There are also individual comments for reading, writing and maths. For each of these subject areas, your child's class teacher has used a colour-coded system to indicate whether your child is **working above the expected standard**, **working at the expected standard** or **working below the expected standard**. In making this judgement, your child's teacher has considered how much of the national curriculum for their age group your child is able to access independently, how much additional support they need and how they compare to national expectations for their year group. The report also includes a short summary of what your child has learned in the other subjects they have studied this year.

You will then see your child's attendance. This is also colour-coded to indicate one of the following:

Your child's attendance is above 97%. They have met the expected target.

Your child's attendance is between 90% and 97%. They are below the expected target.

Your child's attendance is below 90%. They are significantly below the expected target. They are a persistent absentee.

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Your child's teacher has then used the following colour-coding to indicate your child's overall effort and attitude:

Your child almost always displays a positive attitude and works to the best of their ability.

Your child regularly displays a positive attitude and works to the best of their ability.

Your child does not often display a positive attitude and work to the best of their ability.

Finally, the following colour-coding indicates your child's overall behaviour:

Your child almost always follows the school rules and behaves in an acceptable way.

Your child regularly follows the school rules and behaves in an acceptable way.

Your child does not often follow the school rules and behave in an acceptable way.

I would like to point out that anything that is colour-coded **green** on your child's report shows that they are doing everything required to meet the expected standard, so this is a good judgment to receive. Anything colour coded **blue** shows that your child is consistently above the expected standard, or consistently goes above and beyond what is expected of them. This is incredibly hard to achieve.

If you would like to speak to your child's class teacher about your child's report, please do not try to do this at the start or end of the school day as teachers are extremely busy trying to make sure that all children enter and leave the classroom safely. Please call the school office between 10:00am and 2:00pm and make an appointment to speak to your child's teacher at a convenient time.
